Multi-Lift Transport - Bulk Haulage

J.J. Richards' Multi-Lift Transport - Bulk Haulage Division has a fleet of tandem and triaxle vehicles capable of transporting a range of skips and compactor tanks varying in size from $24m^3$ to $66m^3$.

The Multi-lift system is suitable for the transport of such wastes as:

- Building and construction waste materials
- Foundry sand
- Food waste
- Large volumes of general waste.

Used Oil Recycling



J.J. Richards provides waste lubricating oil collection as part of its Total Waste Management service. Where the majority of used oil in Australia is burnt as a relatively cheap fuel, J.J. Richards in association with Southern Oil Refining Pty Ltd, are working towards providing a complete "lube to lube" recycling solution to its customers. This is the most environmentally beneficial and economically sustainable use of a non-renewable resource.

The Southern Oil re-refinery at Wagga Wagga, New South Wales, currently receives over 30 million litres of used oil per annum for refining back into base oil. Together, J.J. Richards and Southern Oil are developing a state of the art 100 million litre per year used oil re-refinery in Gladstone, Queensland, which is expected to open in the latter part of 2014. This will be the first true used oil re-refinery in Queensland, designed to cater for the already significant output of used oil from the State and the projected growth in volumes resulting from the burgeoning resource sector in Northern Australia.

TiTree BioEnergy

The TiTree BioEnergy Facility is a joint venture developed by J.J. Richards and Veolia Environmental Services. The facility is situated on a former open cut coal mine near Ipswich in South East Queensland and uses specially designed landfill cells to rapidly decompose the waste and generate biogas (BioEnergy).
